

Sue Bird's great uncle John William Prettyman was a fisherman in Lowestoft. He was lost at sea on the fishing trawler the 'Lord Haldane', in unknown circumstances during WW2, a long way from his usual fishing area – leaving Sue to wonder what he doing there, so far from home. His death is commemorated on the Tower Hill Memorial for men and women of the Merchant Navy and fishing fleets who were killed as a result of enemy action and have no known grave. Recently, Sue visited the memorial in Trinity Square, whilst on a walk with the photography group, and took this photo.
