In May, twenty-four keen Crafters met to decoupage a little wooden box. We hadn't done any decoupage for a while and for some of the newer members of the group, it was a first. After painting the box and rubbing it down to provide a background, we had to cut out designs from paper serviettes, making sure that we peeled off two of the three ply (very fiddly) otherwise our design would be lumpy as the decoupage glue wouldn't stick well. After we had completed our design, we sealed it with a final coat of gloss or matt Mod-Podge before adding protective feet and hinges to the lid. We were very pleased with our afternoon's work!
